Interstate license compacts offer a streamlined and expedited licensure pathway for eligible practitioners. As more practitioners utilize the expedited licensure pathway, MSPs across all healthcare settings will be impacted. “The Interstate Medical Licensure Compact is an agreement among participating U.S. states and territories to work together to significantly streamline the licensing process for physicians who want to practice in multiple states.”

Operational since 2017. Currently, 41 jurisdictions are IMLC members.

NURSES



“The Nurse Licensure Compact (NLC) increases access to care while maintaining public protection at the state level. Under the NLC, nurses can practice in other NLC states/territories without obtaining additional licenses.”

Implemented in 2000. Currently, 43 jurisdictions are NLC members.

PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS



“The PA Compact is an interstate occupational licensure compact for physician assistants (PAs). The compact facilitates multistate practice for PAs, improves healthcare access for patients, and enhances public protection.”

Activated in 2024 and in process to operationalize. Currently, 13 jurisdictions are compact members.
